



Partner agency policy

For agencies operating under the AllForYouAgencia partnership. How your hosts earn, how BuzzCast pays you, and what support we provide. Figures come from the BuzzCast Agent Monthly Salary policy v24.12 (01/12/2024) except where a section says otherwise.

The two things a host must do

Every payout depends on both being met in the same calendar month. Missing either one means no bonus that month — and no commission for you.

REQUIREMENT	DETAIL
40 valid hours	A valid hour is 60 minutes live. Only 3 count per day, so at least 14 days on air. A broadcast starts counting after 20 minutes.
Her Bcoin target	Falling short of a level pays the level she did reach — there is no partial credit between levels. Reaching no level at all pays nothing.

Time removed for a rule violation does not count. The month runs on UTC-5. Partial credit applies to hours only: 36 to under 38 valid hours pays 80% of the bonus, 38 to under 39 pays 90%. Below 36 hours pays nothing. The policy does not state what happens between 39 and 40 — we are checking this with BuzzCast.

New host targets

First-time BuzzCast contracts get a lower Bcoin target while they build up. From the third month everyone is on the same target. These are current agency figures, not printed in policy v24.12 — treat this table as the live version.

Signing date also reduces the hour requirement in month one: signed 1st–14th needs 30 valid hours instead of 40, signed 15th–23rd needs 14. Signed 24th to month end has no hour requirement at all, but reaching level E or above pays only half the bonus — and your commission on that host is halved with it.

Refunds

If a viewer's payment is refunded, BuzzCast automatically deducts the related gifts, commission and rewards from the account — the host's and the agency's. The policy sets no limit or time window on this. A refund involving a contracted host also terminates that contract immediately.

Currency

200 Bcoins	1 USD
1 Diamond	1 Bcoin
Minimum withdrawal	10 USD, then unlimited withdrawals
Payout methods	USDT, PayPal, Payoneer, or a diamond reseller



Host pay scale

Gifts are always the host's. Her bonus unlocks when both requirements above are met. The last column is your agency's share, calculated at exactly 25% of her bonus as the policy states — BuzzCast may round to the nearest dollar when it pays.

What your agency earns

Three separate channels, paid to you directly by BuzzCast. They stack — the same host can pay into all three.

CHANNEL	RATE	NOTES
Commission	25% of her bonus	Paid on every host in your agency who qualifies. No bonus means no commission.
Member Award	\$1–\$3 per new host	Counts only active new hosts: first-ever BuzzCast contract, 400+ valid minutes and 200+ valid Bcoins that month. Nothing below 11.
Bcoins reward	4%–11% of volume	Rate is set by LAST month's total volume, so month one usually pays nothing.



Member Award brackets

An active new host is one on her first-ever BuzzCast contract who reaches at least 400 valid minutes and 200 valid Bcoins in the month. Hosts who fall short of that do not count towards the bracket.

1–10	nothing
11–20	\$1
21–30	\$2

above 80	the table stops at 80

The policy does not state whether the rate applies to every host once you cross a bracket, or only to the hosts inside that bracket. At 30 active new hosts that is the difference between \$60 and \$30. We are confirming this with BuzzCast — do not plan around either figure until we do.

Bcoins reward tiers

LAST MONTH'S AGENCY BCOINS	TIER	RATE
below 1,000,000	—	nothing
1,000,000 – 2,999,999	Bronze	4%
3,000,000 – 5,999,999	Silver	6%
6,000,000 – 7,999,999	Gold	9%
8,000,000 and above	Gold+	11%

The rate is set by last month's volume and then applied to this month's volume, paid in Bcoins. Volume you build this month buys next month's rate, so a growing agency is always paid at a rate set by its smaller past self — and month one pays nothing here.

You are paid directly by BuzzCast

Your agency is autonomous. BuzzCast pays you at the rates above — commission, Member Award and the Bcoins tier — against your own agency ID and your own hosts. AllForYouAgencia does not take a cut of any of it and does not sit between you and BuzzCast.

For transparency: policy v24.12 refers to a sub-agency invitation reward but does not publish its terms. If BuzzCast pays one for your registration, it is paid by BuzzCast to us and takes nothing away from what you earn. We will tell you the terms once we have them in writing.

Your hosts enter **your** agency ID when they sign, not ours. Check the confirmation screen shows your agency name before you approve anyone.

What AllForYouAgencia provides

You run your own agency. What we cover is training and technical support.

- **Training** — how to onboard a new host, build a schedule around the 3-hour daily cap, improve cover photos, and get hosts through the month-two target jump.



- **Technical** — contract and verification problems, hosts who cannot find the cash-out button on iPhone, payout method questions, and anything the app does that does not make sense.
- **Policy** — we pass on BuzzCast policy changes as we receive them, so you are not working from a stale copy.

What we do not do: we do not manage your hosts, set your internal rules, or handle your payouts. Those are yours.

What you are responsible for

- Every host in your agency must be 18 or over. No exceptions, and no host may let a minor appear on stream. This is the one rule that ends an account and a device permanently, and it is on you to enforce it.
- Explain the 40 valid hours before she signs, not after. The 3-hour daily cap means at least 14 days on air every month, which is the commitment most new hosts underestimate.
- Make sure every host enters **your** agency ID and that the confirmation screen shows your agency name. A wrong ID puts her in someone else's agency and neither of you is paid for her.
- Never promise a specific income. Earnings depend entirely on her own streams.
- Never charge a host to join or to stay. Taking money from hosts is not permitted under this partnership, and BuzzCast pays you separately for exactly this reason.

Recruiting rules

- A host with a verified account in another agency cannot transfer. She must delete the account and wait 15 days before registering again.
- A host with an account that was never verified as a host cannot use the registration flow. She is added to an agency directly — contact us if you need help doing this.
- Anyone new, or who deleted an account more than 15 days ago, registers through your own agency's registration link and then enters your agency ID at the contract step. BuzzCast issues both to you once your agency is live — ask us if you cannot find them.

Where hosts get the rules

buzzcast.allforyouagencia.com carries the full pay scale, the requirements, the streaming guidelines and the join steps in eleven languages, with no agency earnings shown anywhere on it. Use it as a reference for your own hosts — note that its join steps quote our agency ID, so tell your hosts to use yours instead.
